The UC Irvine School of Humanities along with the Humanities Center, HumaniTech and the UCI Libraries is sponsoring on May 19-21 a free conference on the changing nature of book and journal publishing.

The future of the small journal, the independent news source, and the literary magazine seem to be in doubt with the increasing conglomeration of media by large corporations. This conference will gather prominent writers, editors and academics to ask how book and journal publishing matters in the 21st century. The conference will primarily be a series of roundtable question and answer sessions.

Authors participating include: Aimee Bender, Glen David Gold, David Halberstam, Maile Meloy and Mike Sager. Publications represented include: The LA Times, The Nation, The Atlantic Monthly, The LA Weekly, The OC Weekly, and Vanity Fair.

OCLA Scholarship

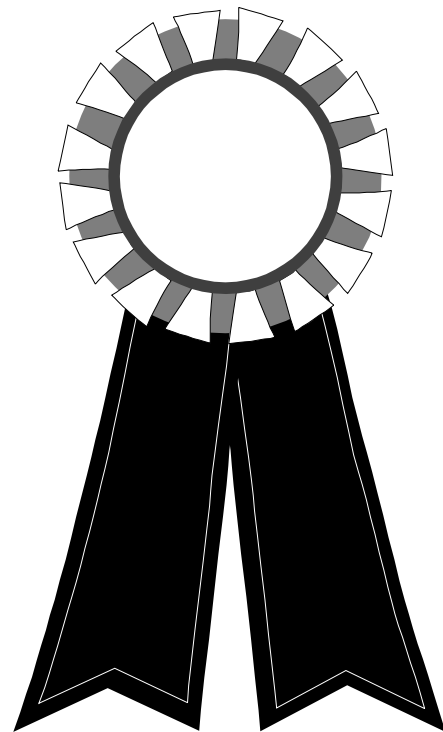
Each year OCLA awards a scholarship to a deserving library studies student (alternating annually between a student in the SJSU SLIS program and one in the Santa Ana College Library Technology Program).

Through your donations and dues this year OCLA will be awarding 600.00 to a San Jose State University, SLIS student.

The student must be an OC resident or employed in a OC Library. They must have also completed 3 core courses in the SJSU SLIS program with a B grade or better. The applicant also submits a resume and a 4 page essay describing their personal background and professional goals.

Selection of the scholarship is based on academic achievement, professional activity, scholarly contributions to Library Science through written works and projects, and the quality of their personal essay

At the time of this newsletter we did not have the winner's name but the winner will be at the OCLA Spring program to accept their check.

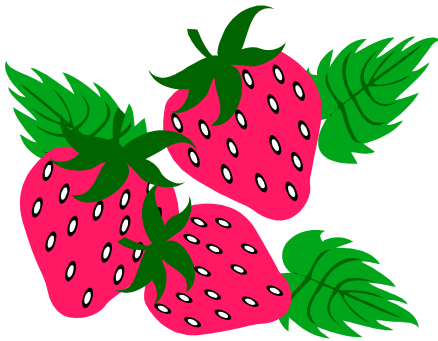
