



Orange County Library Association 2009 Scholarship

In 2009, OCLA will award two **\$250** scholarships to students in the **Santa Ana College Library Technology Program**. The scholarship recipients will be awarded the scholarships at the OCLA Spring Program.

Qualifying criteria:

- Applicants must be continuing Santa Ana College Library Technology students
- Applicants may not apply for the scholarship during their last semester in the LT Program
- Applicants must be an Orange County resident or employed in an Orange County library
- Applicants must have completed *at least* two core courses in the LT Program with a B grade or better
- Applicants must be in good standing with the LT Program and may not have any outstanding incompletes

The following selection criteria apply when awarding the scholarship:

- Academic achievement, including Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Number of classes completed
- Overall quality of the essay (writing style and intellectual content)
- Membership, activity, and support in professional and/or community organizations
- Contributions to the library profession through volunteer projects, written works, projects, or programs

Submit the following to Apply:

- A resume
- A list indicating the numbers/titles of courses completed and GPA
- An essay (not exceeding two pages) that describes your personal background and professional goals and explains how your coursework, professional activities, and/or extracurricular activities in which you are involved demonstrate the ways in which you are contributing to the LT program and the profession.
