What goes into the process of book binding? Have you ever wanted to learn more about restoration and custom binding? Join us for another fun and informative program. We will tour Kater-Crafts Bookbinders in Pico Rivera. Kater-Crafts, founded in 1948 with a current staff of 50, is the largest and oldest library bindery in Southern California. In addition to regular bindery work for libraries, they also perform restoration work for libraries, rare book dealers, and individual collectors.

There is no charge for the book bindery tour. A \$5 donation to the OCLA scholarship fund with cash or checks payable to OCLA is encouraged. Donations will be collected at the event or mailed in advance (see below). **Attendees have the option of attending the 10 a.m. or 1 p.m. tour.** Tours last for 90 minutes. **All are invited to an optional, informal lunch from 11:45 a.m. - 12:45 p.m. at Mario's Tacos located approximately 4 blocks from Kater-Crafts.** Attendees will make their own menu selections and pay individually.
