General Information

Admission

Undergraduate: Students must have completed 12 or more transferable semester credits or the equivalent for admission to University College. A minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA in all prior college-level coursework is required for formal admission into an undergraduate program.

Graduate: Application for Admission should be completely in a timely manner. Students who complete coursework but who do not complete the admission process (or who are denied and later achieve admission) will be permitted to use only 12 credits of completed coursework toward a degree program.

Financial Aid

Students are not eligible for financial aid until regular admission status is achieved. For information on deadlines to apply for loans, grants and scholarships, see your financial aid advisor.

Distance Learning (Online Courses)

To provide increased access to high quality education Chapman offers an online option for a selection of courses in existing undergraduate and graduate programs. Students should consult their academic advisor for guidance and restrictions.

Web Advisor is a web interface that allows a student to access Chapman University's administrative database. Its function is to provide students direct web access to portions of their academic and financial records, as well as the ability to register through the web. Information available to students includes their personal course schedule, transcripts, financial aid award information, and their academic program evaluation information. Library Resources and Services

The Thurman Clarke Memorial Library's web page -- www.chapman.edu/library -- is the starting point for accessing the book holdings, periodical indexes (including full text) and an extensive listing on on-line reference sources. Library instruction is available throughout the academic year.
