Criteria for Success: A candidate exiting the Multiple Subject Credential, the Single Subject Credential, the Education Specialist (Special Education) Credential, or a combination of credentials must be rated at least “Competent” in all areas with three of the four areas rated “Accomplished” or “Distinguished”.
