





Conceptions and Concepts

- Conception = mental image
- Concept = family of conceptions
- Terms label them




Conceputalization




- Refining/specifying our concepts
- Example of anomie and anomia

Indicators and Dimensions

- Misconception of what's real
- Religious dimensions
- Political dimensions
- Socioeconomic dimensions



Interchangeability of Indicators



- Can't define religiosity unambiguously
- What are some definitions/indicators
- But we can determine what causes it (!?)
